

Adopt-A-Street

Changing Barnegat, One Street at a Time

Proposal:

The Adopt A Street program enables students and residents to actively participate in enhancing the overall appearance of Barnegat streets. Volunteers adopt one-mile segments of a street and agree to remove trash for a minimum of three times per year.

Rules:

- A one mile selection of a major street or one whole residential street
- A minimum of three times a year cleaning
- Minors must have parental supervision or parental consent and be in groups
- Cleanups occur in daytime hours only
- Prior to cleanup tell police what time you are planning to clean
- Report (Do NOT pick up) all suspicious items to the Barnegat Police Department at (609) 698-5000
- Clean both sides of the street
- Show evidence of before and after cleanup to get hours/credit (pictures)
- Separate recycling and trash
- Alert authorities of suspicious items

Town Duties:

- Assigned designee will make sure adoptees are maintaining their street
- Sign off on hours if proper evidence is given

Process:
